

SIQT study: Salt Number 1 Postpaid Mobile Service Provider

The Swiss Institute for Quality Tests (SIQT) - an independent consulting and testing institute for consumers – has recently released its test results of the Mobile Service Provider Study 2024. In this study, Salt took first place among Swiss providers in the overall test assessment of postpaid mobile providers.

In a comprehensive study, the independent Swiss Institute for Quality Testing (SIQT) examined 17 mobile phone providers across a number of critical factors, including range of offers, transparency and convenience, conditions, and telephone customer service. Salt emerged as the overall winner in the postpaid sector, achieving a score of 5.6 with a total satisfaction rate of 92.7%.
