Salt Again Recognised for the Best Fixed Broadband Performance in Switzerland, According to Nperf

Salt maintains unrivalled fixed-network internet performance, leading the 2025 Nperf rankings in Switzerland by a comfortable margin. In 2025, Salt subscribers enjoyed the best-performing fixed broadband, ranked nuMbiter one by Nperf overall, for FTTH and Wi-Fi performance, and leading four key performance indicators, including download speed, upload speed and latency, while sharing first place in video streaming quality. Salt's impressive performance highlights the strength of its single 10 Gbit/s technology-based offering, underpinning the success of Salt Home and further enhanced by the recent launch of the Wi-Fi 7 based Salt Home+ offering.



On January 14, 2026, Nperf, an independent global provider of internet performance tests, published its [annual barometer of fixed internet connections](#) for Switzerland performed by its users throughout 2025. Salt reaffirmed its market leadership in fixed broadband internet performance during this period, clearly outperforming its peers. The company retained its number one position in Nperf's ranking across all fixed-line technologies, achieving top results for overall broadband performance, FTTH, download speeds (684.79 Mbit/s), upload speeds (504.23 Mbit/s), and latency (11.64 ms). These results also confirm Salt's position as the best-performing Wi-Fi and FTTH provider. This superior performance is driven by Salt's strategic choice to rely exclusively on state-of-the-art Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) technology and the company's strategic decision to deploy symmetrical, 10 Gbit/s-ready equipment. Built on XGS-PON technology, Salt's FTTH solution delivers outstanding connectivity, with superior results across download and upload speeds as well as latency.

Best Wi-Fi and FTTH with superior Download, Upload Speeds and Lowest Latency

According to Nperf's latest results, Salt leads the market in both Wi-Fi and FTTH performance. Salt has pushed its average download speed to 684.79 Mbit/s, enabling smooth HD streaming and fast downloads. Compared to the previous year, Salt wins the race with an increase of 114.19 Mbit/s (+20%), placing it ahead of its competitors, according to the Nperf indicator. When it comes to upload speeds, Salt's performance increased by 56.23 Mbit/s (+12.6%) compared to the previous year, reaching 504.23 Mbit/s - ideal for seamless video conferencing and efficient content sharing. Salt's average upload speeds are also higher than its competitors. Moreover, Salt Home customers experienced the lowest latency (11.64 ms) compared to the market.

Continuous Improvement in Network Quality

Thanks to its state-of-the-art FTTH fixed network, Salt has been recognised for best FTTH performance, reflecting continuous investment in network quality and the rollout of next-generation Wi-Fi technology. Building on this strong performance, Salt's fibre-based broadband offering is currently accessible to approximately 2.9 million households, representing around 60% of all households in Switzerland, with coverage expected to approach three million. Customers can access Salt's fixed services starting at CHF 39.95 with Salt Home. The recently launched Salt Home+ builds on this offering with next-generation Wi-Fi 7 router technology and includes premium content from Sky and Canal+.
