Salt confirms Second Place in the 2026 Chip Network Test – once again rated “Very Good”

Prilly, April 17, 2026 – Salt ranks second for the second consecutive year in the 2026 Chip Network Test, conducted in collaboration with Net Check, and has been awarded a “Very Good” rating for the fourth consecutive year.

Salt further improved its performance compared to last year, achieving an overall score of 1.12 on a scale where 1.0 represents the highest possible rating. With this result, Salt not only earns a “Very Good” rating but also qualifies for the highest distinction of an “Excellent Network.” Salt particularly stands out in 5G availability, which improved by 1.5% year-on-year, marking the strongest progress among Swiss mobile network operators. The company maintains its position in second place and narrows the gap to Swisscom to just 0.08 points.

The rating scale ranges from 1.0 (very good) to 6.0 (inadequate); lower scores indicate better performance.
